Bright blue......almost too pretty, but if you like a nice blue, it's great. Deep purple....imagine an eggplant with a slight sparkle. That's it. Lt. Green Metallic.....soft, silvery green. It's hard to hate this one! Lt. Blue Metallic.....did you see the review in B. Guide? Same color. Yellow Pearl....not shocking yellow. Soft, with a fine white flake. Silver...very fine flake silver. Slightly darker than it appears here. Tusk....This one looks too white. Think "cream." Burnt orange it will be browner than this. This looks slightly red. Deep Green gorgeous emerald, gets darker as it rolls away. Nice! Bleu-grey ... not quite as "robin's egg" as it appears here. Bad film? Tan.... darker than shown, but "tan" is misleading. Golden Olive metallic pea soup, with a gold highlight.
